HOI also offers two community therapeutic programs — Intensive Family Intervention (IFI) and Community — Based Alternatives for Youth (CBAY) and a residential program. Both the IFI and CBAY programs provide home-based crisis intervention plans used to prevent out-of-home placement for children and youth in families experiencing crisis.

Our residential program serves DFCS youth age 10 -17 with mild to moderate behavioral issues. The residence is designed to create a comfortable, homelike setting with supportive staff and counselors for youth experiencing out-of-home placement.

Our programs utilize support systems and counseling services that actively involve youth and families in creating their own success.
